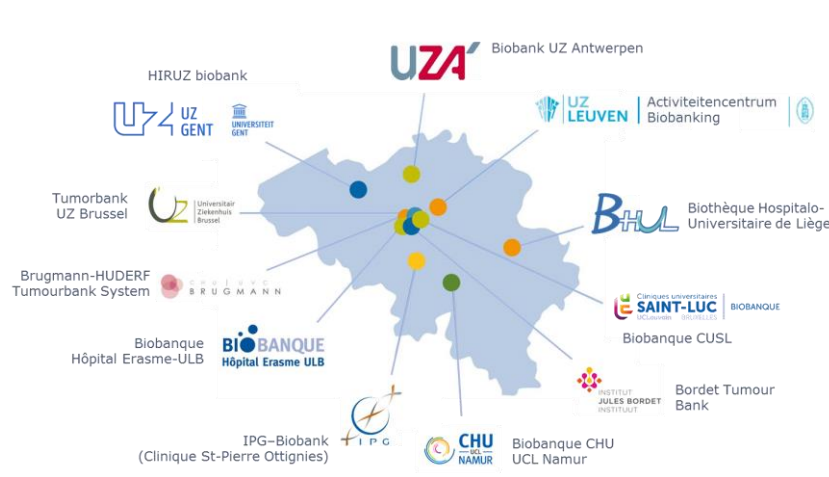




Looking for human tumour samples?

Have a look at the Belgian Virtual Tumourbank - catalogue !



The Belgian Virtual Tumourbank (BVT) project consists of a network of eleven tumourbanks from Belgian university hospitals. To facilitate the search for tumour samples scattered among different institutions, one central database collects data from residual material of human tumours. This data is made available for researchers via an online tool: the Belgian Virtual Tumourbank catalogue (BVTc). The BVTc contains general, patient, medical and technical data.

Access to the BVT Catalogue (BVTc)

Quick search for sample availability

WHO

Belgian researchers active in the broad field of oncology (both from non-profit and profit research organisations).

WHAT

Full access to the online BVTc, to obtain detailed sample level information.

HOW

 → Send (with requested attachments) to biobank@kankerregister.org.

WHO

Any researcher active in the broad field of oncology (both from non-profit and profit research organisations).

WHAT

Easily verify the number of samples of interest registered in the BVTc and the contact info of the local biobanks hosting these samples.
